## Day 1 Arrival to Cape Town

Cape Town is one of the world's most beautiful and magical cities. Surrounded by sea, mountains and unique nature, this city is Africa's most visited and loved travel destinations.

You will be met at the airport by our guide and taken to Underberg Guest House where we have a welcome briefing.

The Underberg is a 4\* Victorian Guest House from 1860 in the genuine Tamboerskloof part of the city. Tamboerskloof is a friendly, pretty and safe area with view of Table Mountain. You will find many local restaurants and shops within walking distance and it is only 5-10 min by taxi to the famous shopping- and entertainment area Waterfront.



## Day 1 - 5 Enjoy Cape Town, stay at the Underberg Guesthouse

- World famous Table Mountain – panorama views, fantastic nature walking trails, take the cable car up or for the fit ones – hike! Enjoy a snack or why not a sun downer on top?
- Victoria & Alfred Waterfront – our world famous shopping and entertainment area – still being a working harbour, why not enjoy a boat trip. The Two Oceans Aquarium is famous for its modern and large shark tanks.
- Green Market Square – open air African market where souvenir bargains can be made, lively and fun!

- Boulders Beach penguin colony – maybe the only land based penguin colony in the world – try swimming with them!
- Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens – one of the world's most beautiful and stay for a meal or picnic!
- Robben Island: see how Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for almost 20 years
- World of Birds – Africa's largest bird sanctuary; over 3000 birds, monkeys, lemurs and other small animals. You can interact with some of the monkeys which is great fun!
- Mount Nelson Hotel – traditional High Tea is served daily at this exclusive, famous and historical landmark of hotel
- Township trips: experience how most South Africans live – busy, vibrant and emotional
- Food & Wine: world class gourmet food and wine at very reasonable prices allows you to feast!
- Adventure! Hiking, climbing, scuba diving, wave surfing, mountain biking, bicycling, hang gliding, sailing, kayaking, white shark cage diving, surfing, mountain biking, hang gliding – and much more!
- Visit a diamond cutting factory - Jewel Africa has informative and free tours about the gold and diamonds.

## Day 5 – 7 La Fontaine Guest House, Franschhoek

Our driver will meet you in the morning at the Underberg and take you an hour inland to the wine area and the picturesque and exclusive village of Franschhoek – Africa's wine and gourmet capital. Check in at the charming and central La Fontaine Guest House – central in town with walking distance to restaurants, shops and wine estates for tastings.

The Franschhoek valley is full of history and dates back to the Huguenots that came over 300 years ago and brought their winemaking skills and French food traditions. On the Franschhoek's main street, you will find galleries, boutiques, cafes in French style and of course many fine restaurants.



**Day 7 – 10 Safari - Elephant Plains Game Lodge, Sabi Sands/Kruger Park**

After breakfast and in time for your flight, you will again meet our driver that will take you to Cape Town airport for 0 yea flight to Kruger. At the airport in Kruger, you will be met and driven into the safari reserve to check in at the small and friendly Elephant Plains Game Lodge..



The Sabi Sands – one of the few remaining true wilderness areas of the world - of the Kruger Greater National Park is the most rich in animals and without doubt the most sought after and exclusive safari area. It is a private area just south of the Kruger National Park and has no fences allowing the animals to wander freely between the reserves and maximizing your game viewing. The overwhelming animal life and the spectacular nature can be breath-taking and exhilarating when you follow the animals and tracks "off road". This will be a memory for life.



Elephant Plains is a privately owned and run lodge within the Sabi Sand Game Reserve, part of the 2,2 million hectare Greater Kruger National Park. Over many years, the strict conservation policies and successful habitat management have resulted in a rich diversity of fauna and flora. Here you will come face to face with Africa’s Big Five and may be lucky enough to encounter other rarer species such as the endangered wild dogs and cheetah. All meals and two safari drives/walks are included daily.

You will be collected after breakfast for transfer to the airport (Hoedspruit) for your flight to Johannesburg connecting with your flight home.
